Future plans include the addition of Chinese language classes and an expansion to $K{\sim}12$.

PREPARATORY ENGLISH PROGRAM (PEP)

To prepare our students for classes taught in English, ICA will conduct a Preparatory English Program (PEP) starting on April 21, 2003. PEP is highly recommended for children who speak Japanese as their primary language and who have limited English speaking abilities.

ACCREDITATION

ICA is a member of the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), and we are pursuing accreditation through ACSI. ACSI supports over 5,500 Christian schools in 100 nations and provides curriculum materials as well as



accreditation services and teacher/administrator training. ACSI accreditation is internationally recognized and will enable students to pursue higher education and prepare for a career in the international community.
